Owl

Name: Owl

Food: Most owls hunt insects, small mammals and other birds.

Habitat: They nest in trees, holes in the ground, barns, and in caves.

Life Span: About 4 years

Fun Fact There are around 200 different owl species

Fox

Name: Fox

Food: Small mammals, reptiles, frogs, insects, fish, fruits, seeds.

Habitat: A hole in the ground or elsewhere, such as under a garden shed.

Life Span: 2 - 5 years

Fun Fact Foxes have whiskers on their legs and face, which help them to navigate.

Rabbit

Name: Rabbit

Food: Fresh fruits and vegetables and lots of fresh hay.

Habitat: Meadows, woods, forests, grasslands, deserts and wetlands.

Life Span: 3 years

Fun Fact Like humans, bunnies get bored easily.

Hedgehog

Name: Hedgehog

Food: Worms, snails, slugs and insects.

Life Span: 2 - 5 years

Squirrel

Name: Squirrel
Food: Hazelnuts, beechnut and seeds like spruce and pine.
Habitat: Wooded areas, as they prefer to live in trees.
Life Span: About 6 years

Fun Fact Squirrels are born blind.

Raccoon

Name: Raccoon
Food: Fruits, plants, nuts, berries, insects, rodents, frogs, etc.
Habitat: Heavily wooded areas with access to trees, water and vegetation.
Life Span: 2 - 3 years

Stag

Food: Plants, fruits, acorns, nuts, grass and evergreen plants.
Habitat: Hardwoods, croplands, brushland, pasturelands.
Life Span: 18 - 25 years

Fun Fact Male deer grow new antlers each year.
